ORDINANCE NO. 021
Series of 1987

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5, SERIES OF 1945, PROVIDING STIFFER PENALTIES FOR ILLEGAL GAMBLINGS COMMITTED WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF OTON, PROVINCE OF ILOILO.

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to update gambling ordinance for simplicity and clearer understanding and to provide stiffer penalties for their violators to make them more effective and responsive to the present conduct and behavior of the people.

WHEREAS, the penalties provided under Ordinance No. 5, Series of 1945 for illegal gamblings are rendered obsolete and negligible by the present situation as deterrent to minimize if not to eliminate its commission within the Municipality of Oton, Iloilo.

NOW THEREFORE on motion of Hon. Ewigio Acosta and duly seconded by Hon. Ramon Panique, be it that:

SECTION 1 - Penalties - that the penalty amount of FIFTY PESOS (P50.00) as amended is increased to TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00) for the first offense, THREE HUNDRED PESOS (P300.00) for the second offense and FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00) for the succeeding offenses and/or imprisonment from one (1) month but not more than three (3) months for recedevist and shall also be imposed upon any person who shall knowingly and without lawful purpose in any hour of any day shall have in his possession any lottery list, paper or other matter containing letters, figures, signs or symbols which pertain to in any manner used in the game of justing, jai-alai or horse racing bookies, and similar game or lottery which is taking place or about to take place.

SECTION 2 - That the said Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days upon approval.

SECTION 3 - Provide copies to the Municipal Treasurer, Station Commander, and the Office of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for information and appropriate action.
