ORDINANCE NO. 28
Series of 1994

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION II-I AND SECTION IV OF ORDINANCE NO. 22 SERIES OF 1992, NOW AMENDED REPEALING ALL PARTS OF SAID ORDINANCE IN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF OTOS.

WHEREAS, Section II-I of Ordinance No. 22, Series of 1992 on the definition of the Municipal Waters was based from Sec. 3 (a) of PD 204 otherwise known as the Philippine Decree of 1973;

WHEREAS, with the effectivity of RA 7160 on January 1, 1992 the definition of the Municipal Waters of Ordinance No. 22 series of 1992 is void;

SECTION II - DEFINITIONS:

1. Municipal Waters shall include not only streams, lakes and tidal waters within the Municipality but also the subject of private ownership and not covered within the national parks, public forest, timber lands, forest reserves or fishery reserves, but the main water, located between the two lines perpendicularly to the general coastline from points where the boundary line of the Municipality on city beach the sea at low tide and a third line parallel with the general coastline and fifteen (15) kilometers from it. Where two (2) Municipalities are situated in the opposite shores and there is less than fifteen (15) kilometers of marine waters between them, the third line shall be equally distant from the opposite shores of the respective municipalities.

WHEREAS, Section IV of Ordinance No. 22 series of 1992 does not need departmental approval based on the provision of RA 7160, then it is void.

SECTION IV - REPEALING CLAUSE

1. This Ordinance shall take effect after ten (10) days of posting at two (2) conspicuous places upon approval.

APPROVED on motion of Hon. Danilo W. Bailley and duly seconded by Hon. Eusebio S. Villay Garcia be it

APPROVED as well as HEREBY PASSED to pass and approve this Ordinance Amending Section II-I and Section IV of Ordinance No. 22 Series of 1992, Now Ordinance Regulating the Use of Municipal Waters in the Territorial Jurisdiction of the Municipality of Otos.




