ORDINANCE NO. 99-74

ORDINANCE DECLARING MABINI ST., OTON, ILOILO AS
A ONE WAY STREET FROM NOVEMBER 26 TO DECEMBER
2, 1999 AND EFFECTING ITS TEMPORARY CLOSURE FROM
DECEMBER 3 - 9, 1999 IN CONNECTION WITH THE
CELEBRATION OF THE MUNICIPAL AND RELIGIOUS FIESTA



ON MOTION of the Committee on Public Utilities, namely: Hon. Jose F. Tampus III, Hon. Sabio and Hon. Mary Jean G. de los Santos and duly seconded by Hon. Edgar N. Javellana

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Oton, Iloilo in its Regular Session held at the Municipal Session Hall last November 24, 1999 at 2:00 in the afternoon, an Ordinance to wit:

SECTION 1. INTRODUCTION.

The yearly celebration of the Municipal and Religious Fiesta will be meaningful with the presence of "Ferias" that symbolize real Filipino culture wherein Mabini St. traversing J.C. Zulueta St. and Claro M. Recto St. is the only site to be occupied by the operators of "Ferias" during the celebration.

SECTION 2.

Rule VIII, Article 43 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A. 7160 states that "an LGU may through an ordinance permanently or temporarily close or open any road, alley, park or square within its jurisdiction".

SECTION 3.

Rule VIII, Article 45 of IRR of R.A. 7160 states that "(a) any national or local road, alley, park or square may be temporarily closed during actual emergency or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs or undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications and water works projects, the duration of which shall be specified by the Local Chief Executive concerned in a written order, as follows:
1. During Fiesta Celebrations - for a period not exceeding nine (9) days."

SECTION 4.

Rule VIII, Article 45 of IRR of R.A. 7160 states that "(b) any LGU may temporarily close and regulate the use of any local street, road or thoroughfare or public place where shopping malls, Sunday markets, flea or night markets or shopping area may be established and where goods, merchandise, foodstuff, commodities, or articles of commerce may be sold and dispensed to the general public.

SECTION 5.

PROHIBITED AND REGULATED ACTS.
1. All motor vehicles both private and public passing Mabini St. shall temporarily pass Rizal St. extension or any accessible or convenient route.
2. There shall be installed traffic signs for the information of everybody.

SECTION 6.

EXCEPTIONS.
Only triskad may pass Mabini St. during daytime except on December 7-8, 1999.

SECTION 7.

EFFECTIVITY.
This shall take effect November 26 to December 2, 1999 as a One-Way Street, and on December 3 - 9, 1999, Temporarily Closed.

SECTION 8.

Copies of this Ordinance shall be furnished to the Office of the Mayor, Oton-PNP, ABC, SK, Bgy. Pob. West, Pob. South, Pob. East, Pob. North, and the Sangguniang Pambayan of Iloilo for information and guidance.
