ORDINANCE NO. 2000 - 81

**ORDINANCE DELINEATING BOUNDARIES OF
THE MUNICIPAL COASTAL WATERS OF OTON.**

AS PROPOSED by Hon. Mario D. Balandra, on motion of the Committee on Legal Affairs, namely: Hon. Felimon Gregorio M. Calvo, Hon. Edgar N. Javellana and Hon. Vicente B. Flores, Jr. and duly seconded by Hon. Jose Neil P. Olivares and Hon. Honorato P. Nad

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Oton, Iloilo, an Ordinance to wit:

SECTION 1. DEFINITION.

1. **Established General Coastline (EGC)** - an imaginary straight line running from the boundary of Iloilo and Antique in Sinugbahan, San Joaquin, Iloilo and the tip of the mouth of Iloilo River which has a compass reading of Az 68 degrees.
2. **Municipal Coastal Water** - the body of seawater included between two (2) parallel lines drawn perpendicular to the established general coastline (Az 68 degrees) and are bounded by the third line connecting the midpoints of the two (2) parallel lines from the shoreline of Oton towards the shoreline of Guimaras Island. The parallel lines with bearing 322 degrees East, run from the center post of the old Barroc Bridge in Tigbayan and from the boundary post of Alegre, Oton and Arevalo, Iloilo City.
3. **Municipal Waters** - include not only streams, lakes, inland bodies of water and tidal waters within the Municipality which are not included within the protected areas as defined under RA 7586 (The NIPAS Law), public forest, timber lands, forest reserves or fishery reserves but also marine waters included between two (2) lines drawn perpendicular to the general coastline from points where the boundary lines of the Municipality touch the sea at low tide and a third line parallel with the general coastline including offshore island and fifteen (15) kilometers from such coastline. Where two (2) municipalities are so situated on opposite shores that there is less than thirty kilometers of marine waters between, the third line shall be equally distant from opposite shores of the respective municipalities.

SECTION 2. BASIS OF BOUNDARIES.

The delineation of boundaries of municipal waters in this particular ordinance is based on Administrative Map, Province of Iloilo issued by the National Mapping and Resource Information Authority (NAMRIA), Edition 1 - September 1990 with a Scale 1: 200,000.

SECTION 3. POINTS AND BEARING.

- a. Based on Section 2 above, the Municipal Waters of the Municipality of Oton shall include an area containing approximately 77 square kilometers described as follows:
Beginning at point A marked along the vicinity North - South line 122 degrees 30' and intersecting the shoreline of Arevalo - Oton boundary as shown on the map to point B which is more or less 4.9 kilometers (from point A) is line AB with Bearing South 22 degrees East, from point B to point C which is more or less 8

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kilometers with Bearing South 52 degrees "West, from point C to point D which is more or less 11. kilometers with Bearing North 22 degrees " West; and from point D to point A traversing along the coastline of the Municipality.

- b. An imaginary line drawn from point AA at the mouth of Iloilo (City) River to point BB at the provincial boundary (with Antique) of Sinugbahan, San Joaquin, Iloilo is established as line of reference.
- c. Parallel lines from the shorelines of Iloilo City to San Joaquin, Iloilo are drawn perpendicular to line AABB from which line AB and line CD are drawn as boundary for municipal waters of Oton.
- d. Line BC is taken from midpoints of line AE and DF which extend to the shorelines of Guimaras Island.

SECTION 4. BOUYS AND FLOATERS.

The Local Government Unit through the General Services Office and in coordination with Municipal Agriculture Office and FARMC shall cause the establishment of bouys and/or floaters clearly visible with markings Municipality of Oton at point B and Point C.

SECTION 5. MARKS AND REFERENCE POINT ON THE GROUND.

In the actual ground, Point A shall be the boundary post planted at vicinity boundary of Brgy. Alegre, Oton and Arevalo, Iloilo City.

Point D shall be the center post of the old bridge along the shoreline bounded by Brgy. Cabanbanan, Oton and Brgy. Baroc, Tigbauan.

SECTION 6. BUDGET ALLOCATION FOR MAINTENANCE OF BOUYS & FLOATERS.

An initial budget of Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000) shall be allocated for the establishment and maintenance of bouys or floaters.

An annual budget in the same amount shall be allocated for same purpose.

SECTION 7. PENALTY CLAUSE.

It shall be unlawful to remove or transfer the bouys or floaters established therein. Violators are meted a fine of P2,000.00 or imprisonment of ten days or both upon the discretion of the court.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.

This Ordinance shall take effect one month after its approval upon which enough time is spent for information dissemination and coordination with City Government and LGU Tigbauan.

SECTION 9. Copies of this Ordinances be furnished to the Iloilo City Government; LGU Tigbauan; Office of the Mayor, MBO; MTO; Acctg. Office; MPDC; MTC; Oton-PNP; GSO; MAO; FARMC;
