ORDINANCE NO. 2004-135

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING MABINI STREET, OTON, ILOILO AS A ONE - WAY STREET FROM NOVEMBER 25 TO DECEMBER 6, 2004 AND EFFECTING ITS TEMPORARY CLOSURE FROM DECEMBER 7 TO 9, 2004 IN CONNECTION WITH THE CELEBRATION OF THE CIVIC AND RELIGIOUS FIESTA.

ON MOTION of the Committees on Public Safety, namely, Hon. Pablo S. Guevara, Jr., Hon. Jose Neil P. Olivares and Hon. Edgar N. Javelana and Public Facilities and Utilities, namely: Hon. Simplicio R. Carreon, Jr., Hon. Edgar N. Javelana and Hon. Eusebio G. Villavicencio, Jr. and duly seconded by Hon. Francisca C. Ezpeleta

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Oton, Iloilo, an Ordinance, to wit:

SECTION 1. INTRODUCTION. The yearly celebration of the Civic and Religious Fiesta will be meaningful with the presence of "Ferias" that symbolizes real Filipino culture wherein Mabini Street traversing J. C. Zulueta Street and Claro M. Recto Street is the only site to be occupied by the operators of "Ferias" during the celebration.

SECTION 2. Rule VIII, Article 43 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 7160 states that, "an LGU may through an Ordinance permanently or temporarily close or open any road, alley, park or square within its jurisdiction."

SECTION 3. Rule VIII, Article 45 of IRR of RA 7160 states that "(a) any national or local road, alley, park or square may be temporarily closed during actual emergency or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs or undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunication and water work projects, the duration of which shall be specified by the Local Chief Executive concerned in a written order, as follows: During Fiesta Celebration - for a period not exceeding nine (9) days."

SECTION 4. Rule VIII, Article 45 of IRR of RA 7160 states that "(b) any LGU may temporarily close and regulate the use of any local street, road or thoroughfare or public place where shopping malls, Sunday markets, flea or night markets or shopping area may be established and where goods, merchandise, foodstuff, commodities or articles of commerce may be sold and dispensed to the general public.

SECTION 5. PROHIBITED AND REGULATED ACTS.

- Mabini Street shall be declared a One - Way Street from November 25 to December 6, 2004 and it shall be Temporarily Closed on December 7 - 9, 2004.
- All motor vehicles, both public and private passing Mabini Street shall temporarily pass Rizal Street extension or any accessible or convenient route.
- There shall be installed traffic signs for the information of everybody.

SECTION 6. EXCEPTION. Only Triskad may pass Mabini Street during daytime except on December 7 - 9, 2004.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This shall take effect upon approval.

SECTION 8. COPIES. This Ordinance shall be furnished to the Office of the Mayor; Oton - PNP, MPDC; GSO; ABC and the Sangguniang Pankalawigan of Iloilo for information and guidance.
