ORDINANCE NO. 2006 - 153

**AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY CLOSING THE STREETS
COMPOSING THE ROUTE OF THE OPENING SALVO
PARADE ON APRIL 28, 2006 AND FOR THE MUSICAL, DANCE
AND THEATRE PRESENTATION AND STREET DANCING
COMPETITION ON MAY 3, 2006 DURING THE KATAGMAN FESTIVAL.**

ON MOTION of the Committee on Peace and Order / Public Safety, namely: Hon. Pablo S. Guevara, Jr., Hon. Jose Neil P. Olivares and Hon. Edgar N. Javellana and duly seconded by Hon. Virginia F. Olivares

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Oton, Iloilo, an Ordinance, to wit:


- SECTION 1. INTRODUCTION.** The celebration of the 434th Foundation Day of this Municipality will be highlighted by various activities especially "Balangay Contest" of competing tribes from the different barangays of Oton wherein several roads shall be temporarily closed during the celebration.
- SECTION 2.** Rule VIII, Article 45 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 7160 states that, "an LGU may through an Ordinance permanently and temporarily close or open any road, alley, park or square within its jurisdiction."
- SECTION 3.** Rule VIII, Article 45 of IRR of RA 7160 states that "(a) any national or local road, alley, park or square may be temporarily closed during actual emergency or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs or undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunication and waterworks projects, the duration of which shall be specified by the Local Chief Executive concerned in a written order;
- SECTION 4. REGULATED ACTS.**
1. Southern and Northern bound private and public vehicles shall pass through Diversion Road, Oton, San Jose Road, Claro M. Recto, Burgos and J. C. Zulueta Streets during the Opening Salvo Parade on April 28, 2006 from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM and during the Balangay Contest and Street Dancing Competition on May 3, 2006 from 3:00 PM to 9:00 PM.
 2. Claro M. Recto, Burgos, Rizal, Mabini, J. C. Zulueta (in front of the Public Market), Bonifacio and Lopez Jaena Streets shall be temporarily closed on April 28, 2006 for the Opening Salvo Parade.
 3. Rizal Street Extension and the Road in front of the Catholic Church shall be declared temporarily closed on May 3, 2006 to accommodate the props of the competing tribes.
 4. Claro M. Recto, Mabini, J.C. Zulueta (in front of the Public Market), Bonifacio and portion of Lopez Jaena Streets shall be declared temporarily closed on May 3, 2006 for the Street Dancing Competition.
 5. There shall be PNP personnel and Traffic Aides to man the area for direction and rerouting of all passing vehicles.
- SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.** This shall take effect on April 28, and on May 3, 2006.
- SECTION 6. COPIES.** This Ordinance shall be furnished to the Office of the Mayor; Oton PNP; Barangays Poblacion West, Poblacion South, Poblacion East and Poblacion North; ABC; SK; GSO; OMPDC and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Iloilo for information and guidance.


