**ORDINANCE NO. 2015 – 273**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2014–270,  
ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE  
2012 – 244, AN ORDINANCE REGULATING BIRTH DELIVERIES IN  
THE MUNICIPALITY OF OTON.**

**ON MOTION** of the Committee on Health and Sanitation composed by Hon. Rodolfo Z. Alconga, Jr., Hon. Jafet P. Salinas, Hon. Leonida C. Alison which was duly seconded by Juan Miguel M. Flores,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Bayan of Oton, Iloilo, that:

**SECTION 1. INTRODUCTORY CLAUSE.**

- a) There is Provincial Ordinance No. 2014-112 entitled: "An Ordinance on the Standardized Utilization of PhilHealth Insurance Corporation (PHIC) Maternity Care Package (MCP) and Newborn Care Package (NCP) Benefits in the Rural Health Units of Iloilo Province"; which is also embodied in SP Resolution 2014–263 of the Province of Iloilo.
- b) As embodied in the said ordinance and pursuant to Phil. Health Circular 011-2011, the payment for claims for Maternity Care Package (MCP) is Eight Thousand Pesos (P8,000.00) and for the newborn care package is One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (P1,750.00) in all accredited non-hospital facility.
- c) One of the purposes of the said ordinance is to have a province-wide standardized allocation and utilization of scheme and/or percentage of PHIC's Maternal Care Package (MCP) and Newborn Care Package to sustain the operation and implementation of Maternal and Child Health Services like the provision of quality prenatal and postpartum care attendance and facility-based deliveries, attended by skilled health workers including professional fees.
- d) Section 7 of the said Provincial Ordinance provides for the sharing of allocated amount for professional fees.
- e) This Municipality has an existing Municipal Ordinance no. 2012–244 entitled: An Ordinance Regulating Birth Deliveries In The Municipality Of Oton wherein its section 6 provides also the sharing of allocated amount from PhilHealth, to wit: a. For PhilHealth members – Free of charge since PhilHealth will reimburse the amount of P8,000.00 which shall be divided as follows:
  1. P6,500.00- Health Center facility and attendants  
(P4,000.00 Facility; P1,500.00 Midwife; P1,000.00 Physician)
  2. P1,500.00 – Pre-natal fee
- f) There is a need to amend the said Municipal Ordinance in order to conform to Section 7 of the Provincial Ordinance 2014-112 in which the amount allocated for professional fees shall be divided among the Rural Health Unit personnel with their corresponding shares as embodied in the said Provincial Ordinance.

**SECTION 2. AMENDATORY CLAUSE.** The following underlined provisions shall be the amendments to Section 6 (a) of Municipal Ordinance 2012–244 pursuant to Section 7 of Provincial Ordinance 2014–112 and PHIC Circular 22 S. 2014, to wit:

- a. For PhilHealth members – Free of charge since PhilHealth will reimburse the amount for Maternity Care Package which shall be divided as follows:
  1. Sixty percent ( 60%) of the amount for MCP - shall be intended to the Health Care Facility; and
  2. Forty percent ( 40%) of the amount for MCP - shall be allocated for the professional fees which shall be divided among the following Rural Health Unit personnel with their corresponding shares:

a. Municipal Health Officer	25%
b. Public Health Nurse	12%
c. Rural Health Midwife	55%
d. RHU Medical Technologist	3%
e. Other personnel -Dentist	2%
f. Others	3%
Total	100%

Provided that the Rural Health Unit (RHU) personnel concerned must have performed their duties and responsibilities. Failure on the part of the personnel to perform the said duties and responsibilities will result to the forfeiture of his/her share, without prejudice to administrative, civil, or criminal liability, if applicable. The Municipal Health Officer (MHO) shall have the authority to decide on the official utilization of the forfeited share PROVIDED FURTHER that the same shall only be used for personnel enhancement programs/activities of the Rural Health Unit.

For the New Born Care Package Benefits, the amount of the package shall be Php 1750.00 and paid to the facility with the following components:

Newborn Screening Test (for metabolic diseases)	P550.00
Newborn Hearing Screening Test	P200.00

**SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All municipal ordinances or parts of any municipal ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall continue in operation.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.

**SECTION 6. COPIES.** This Ordinance shall be furnished to the Office of the Mayor, MHO, HRMO, MTO, MBO, Accounting Office, MPDO and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Iloilo for information, guidance and review respectively.
