ORDINANCE NO. 2015 – 277

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY CLOSING PORTION OF SAN ANTONIO- SAN JOSE BY- PASS ROAD THIS MUNICIPALITY STARTING MAY 28, 2015- JUNE 28, 2015 FOR THE CONCRETING OF THE SAID ROAD.

ON MOTION of Hon. Eusebio G. Villavicencio, Jr. which was duly seconded by Hon. Juan Miguel M. Flores.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Oton, Iloilo, that:

SECTION 1. Introduction. The San Antonio- San Jose By - Pass Road in this Municipality, also known as Hanil Road connects the National highway in Brgy. San Antonio, near Batiano Bridge to San Jose National Road. The said road measuring 500 meters long and 9 meters wide is in a dilapidated condition. Considering the availability of funds, portion of the said road measuring 103 meters long by 6. 10 meters wide from the National Highway in Brgy. San Antonio will be concreted.

SECTION 2. Temporary Closure of Portion of San Antonio- San Jose By Pass Road . Pursuant to Section 21 (c) of R.A. 7160, the Local Government Code of 1991, Portion of San Antonio –San Jose By Pass Road (Hanil Road) shall be temporarily closed due to public works (concreting of the said road) from May 28, 2015 to June 28, 2015.

SECTION 3. Detour. In connection with the foregoing provision, all vehicles, public and private, including tricycles and trisikads shall utilize alternate routes. Residents and their clients, guests or customers along the said road shall utilize the San Jose Road as entrance and exit.

SECTION 4. Public Information and Guidance. In order to guide the public, there shall be installed:

1. Signages or billboards of temporary nature and materials which shall be provided by the contractor concerned informing the commuters of the temporary closure of Portion of San Antonio –San Jose By Pass Road (Hanil Road) from May 28, 2015 to June 28, 2015;
2. The contractor shall also responsible for the proper dissemination of information to the residents along the said road.

SECTION 5. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect from May 28, 2015 to June 28, 2015.

SECTION 6. Copies. This Ordinance shall be furnished to the Office of the Mayor; Brgy. Poblacion West; Brgy. Tagbac Sur, Brgy. San Antonio; Oton PNP; MDRRMO; MEO; MPDC; CHEDMARYL Construction & Supplies and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Iloilo for information, guidance and review respectively.


