**ORDINANCE NO. 2017 – 301**

**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING EVERY SECONDARY STUDENT  
TO HAVE CAPABILITY TRAINING ON THE BASICS OF  
ELDERLY CARE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF OTON, ILOILO.**

**AS PROPOSED** by Hon. Jafet P. Salinas, **ON MOTION** of the Committee on Social Welfare, Community Development, Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) and Cooperative composed by Hon. Honorato P. Nad, Hon. Jafet P. Salinas, Hon. Ma. Lorna T. Geonigo which was duly seconded by Hon. Margarito T. Clavel III

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Bayan of Oton, Iloilo, that:

**SECTION 1. Introduction**

In the cycle of life each one is destined to grow old. In the Filipino values, it is incumbent upon the younger generations to take care of their elderly. In order to achieve this objective, it is part of the responsibility of the LGU-Oton to capacitate the younger generations on the basics of elderly care.

This Ordinance also aims to ensure that senior citizens in residential homes will receive services of an acceptable standard that meet the very basic requirements of their physical, emotional and social needs.

To achieve this, it is deemed proper to commence this program in schools where the younger generations are breed for life. Thus, the support and cooperation of the DepEd Secondary is essential to realize the purposes for which this Ordinance is crafted.

**SECTION 2. Title.** This Ordinance shall known as the "Basic Elderly Care Ordinance."

**SECTION 3. Definition of Terms.**

- a. Elderly care – is the social and personal requirements of Senior citizens who need some assistance in their daily activities and personal health care maintenance.
- b. Capability – the state of being capable through learning and training.
- c. Secondary Students – all students enrolled in secondary education in the Municipality of Oton.
- d. Teachers – DepEd teaching staff assigned to secondary schools.

**SECTION 4. Responsibilities of the Local Government Unit.**

1. The Local Government Unit of Oton, thru the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) and the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office

(MSWDO) hereby directed to develop and formulate a training module (module of instructions) for this purpose.

- 2. It shall be the responsibility of the MDRRMO and MSWDO to provide for all the necessary training materials.
- 3. The MDRRMO and MSWDO are hereby required to submit to the Local Chief Executive annual assessment report for purposes of monitoring and evaluation of the first year of implementation of the program.

**SECTION 5. Responsibilities of Teachers.**

- 1. It shall be the responsibility of the School Administrator to allow the teachers to capacitate themselves for purposes of this Ordinance.
- 2. The teachers shall attend mandatory training for purposes of the program.
- 3. The teachers shall endeavor to equip their students with necessary skills in meeting the requirements of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6. The module of Instructions will include, but not limited to:**

- a) **Module I** – Introduction to Aging
- b) **Module II** – Characteristics and Milestones of Aging
- c) **Module III** – Common Sickness Affecting the Elderly
- d) **Module IV** – Promoting Healthy Lifestyle for the Elderly
- e) **Module V** – Emergency Management and Care for the Elderly

**SECTION 7. Repealing Clause.** All municipal ordinances or parts of any municipal ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 8. Separability Clause.** If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall continue in operation.

**SECTION 9. Effectivity Clause.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.


