ORDINANCE NO. 2022 – 381

AN ORDINANCE GIVING MORATORIUM ON PAYMENT OF BUSINESS TAX AND REGULATORY FEES FOR 6 MONTHS FOR CY 2022 FOR THOSE STALL OWNERS AFFECTED BY FIRE AT THE OTON PUBLIC MARKET LAST DECEMBER 20, 2021, AMENDING THE TAX AND REVENUE CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF OTON, ILOILO AS EMBODIED IN ORDINANCE 2013-256 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 2017-314.

AS PROPOSED BY Hon. Anna Rena P. Trespeses, **ON MOTION** of the Committee on Ways and Means composed by Hon. Anna Rena Ponsaran Trespeses, Hon. Lee Cereneo Alison, Hon. Grace Marie Escanlar-Cruz which was duly seconded by Hon. Vanessa T. Salinas and Hon. Jimmy R. Olivares,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Oton, Iloilo, that:

SECTION 1. RATIONALE. A massive fire occurred on the midnight of December 19, 2021 to December 20, 2021 which totally destroyed 80% of the Oton Public Market Structure including the stalls with estimated P45, 000,000.00 more or less damage. As part of the Social Responsibility of the Local Government Unit of Oton, there is a need to amend/modify the Municipal ordinance no. 2013-256 and as Amended by Municipal Ordinance 2017-314 particularly on payment of Business Taxes and Regulatory Fees for 6 months from January to June 2022 to those affected stall owners with stall(s) totally burned. A committee/public hearing was conducted and the committee rendered Committee Report No. 2022-01.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY CLAUSE. There shall be a moratorium for 6 months from January to June 2022 for the imposition of Business Tax and Regulatory Fees on the affected stall owners with stalls totally burned at the Oton Public Market, hereby amending/ modifying Chapter VII Article A of Mun. Ordinance 2013-256 and Chapter III Article A of the Municipal Ordinance no. 2017-314. The affected stall owners shall still secure and pay their Mayor's permit for the year 2022.

SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE CLAUSE. The Office of the Business Permit and Licensing, Municipal Treasurer and Municipal Economic Enterprise Development shall be responsible in the implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval subject to publication based on Section 59 (c) of the Local Government Code of 1991.


SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All municipal ordinances or parts of any municipal ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby modified accordingly until this Ordinance is repealed.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall continue in operation.

SECTION 7. COPIES. This Ordinance shall be furnished to the Office of the Mayor; MTO, MBO, ACCTG, BPLO, MEEDO, MENRO, MHO, ZONING, OTON-BFP, OTON- PNP, OMVA, BLGF and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Iloilo for information, guidance and review respectively.
