ORDINANCE NO. 2023 - 414

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE ANNUAL OBSERVANCE OF THE LINGGO NG KABATAAN IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF OTON, ILOILO EVERY 12TH DAY OF AUGUST AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR, THEREBY REPEALING ORDINANCE 2022-389.

ON MOTION of the Committee on Youth and Sports Development composed by Hon. Ella Mae S. Yeoh, Hon. Dennis Q. Geroche and Hon. Rodolfo Z. Alconga, Jr. which was duly seconded by Hon. Lee Alison - Bretaña

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan ng Oton, Iloilo, that:

Section 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the **“Linggo ng Kabataan Ordinance”**.

Section 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. Pursuant to Section 13 of the Philippines Constitution, the State recognizes the vital role of the Youth in nation-building. It shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being; inculcate in the patriotism and nationalism and encourage their environment in public and civic affairs, thus, Sec. 30, Chapter VI of RA 10742 otherwise known as the SK Reform Act of 2015 provides that every local government unit shall conduct an annual activity to be known as "The Linggo ng Kabataan" on the week where the 12th of August falls to coincide with the International Youth Day.

Section 3. OBJECTIVES. The Local Youth Development Council (LYDC) of Oton spearheaded by the Sangguniang Kabataan Municipal Federation of Oton and youth organizations composing the seek for the institutionalization and full implementation of the ordinance with the cooperation of the Sangguniang Kabataan of each barangay, youth organizations under LYDC, governmental agencies concerned and the community. In line with this, the council shall conduct various programs to achieve the following purposes:

- 3.1. To promote and increase youth engagements through platforms and programs focused on the Philippine Youth Development Plan's 9 centers of participation: Education, Economic Empowerment, Social Inclusion and Equity, Security, Governance, Active Citizenship, Environment and Global Mobility and as determined by the Local Youth Development Plan;
- 3.2. To hold programs and activities that encourage critical thinking, creativity, social awareness and responsibility in youth;
- 3.3. To foster positive relationships between youth organizations, partner agencies, and the young individuals, in general through competitions, leadership trainings, and team-building activities;
- 3.4. To create a proactive youth community which every member recognizes his/her significant role in nation- building.

Section 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS. As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

4.1. **Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR)** shall refer to the IRR of Republic Act 10742 otherwise known as Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act.

4.2. **Local Youth Development Council (LYDC)** shall refer to a multi-sectoral youth association, which shall be called the Oton Municipal Youth Development Council, respectively, headed by the concerned SKMF President and composed of representatives from youth and youth-serving organizations in the municipal level;

4.3. **Local Youth Development Plan (LYDP)** shall refer to the municipal youth development plan as initially drafted by the Sangguniang Kabataan Municipal Federation of Oton, finalized by the LYDC and approved by the local sanggunian. Local Youth Development Plan (LYDP) shall be anchored on the Philippine Youth Development Plan (PYDP) and the local development plans of the local government unit concerned;

4.4. **Philippine Youth Development Plan (PYDP)** shall refer to the comprehensive national plan expressing the convergence efforts of the different youth-serving national agencies, civil society organizations and youth organizations designed to promote the general welfare, development and empowerment of the youth, in preparation for their vital role in nation-building. The formulation of the plan shall be spearheaded by the Commission, and shall be based on the findings of the National Youth Assessment Study, Youth Development Index, and the directions set by the Philippine Development Plan. It may also take into consideration the findings of the different international organizations;

4.5. **Youth** shall refer to Ogtonganons with ages ranging from fifteen (15) to thirty (30) years old as defined in Republic Act No. 8044. For the purpose of targeted programming for the youth, the age disaggregation shall be considered:

15-17 – child youth

18-24 – core youth

25-30 – adult youth;

Section 5. PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES. During the celebration of the Linggo ng Kabataan, various programs and activities shall be conducted for the youth, such as the following:

5.1. **Capacity Building and Educational Programs.** There shall be programs such as trainings and seminar workshops that aim to capacitate and educate the youth on social issues revolving on the environment, education, history, culture, arts, governance and politics, science and technology, agriculture, and many more.

5.2. **Livelihood Trainings.** There shall be trainings for youth from various sectors and groups that center on skills enhancement, financial literacy, entrepreneurship, and employment.

5.3. **Community Service Activities.** There shall be activities focused on community outreach and extensions, clean and green programs, donation drives, dental and medical missions, and other immersions in socially-disadvantaged youth and allied sectors. These activities promote youths' sense of social commitment, social responsibility and civic-mindedness.

5.4. **Outstanding Ogtonganon Youth and Youth Organization.** There shall be a recognition program to award Outstanding Ogtonganon Youth and Youth Organizations which have excelled in fields such as, academe, leadership, government, sports, arts, science and technology, communication and journalism, and many more.

5.4.1. There shall be a panel of judges from various sectors which shall be determined by the Local Youth Development Council or the organizing team.

5.4.2. The criteria and guidelines for determining the Outstanding Ogtonganon Youth and Youth Organization shall be promulgated by the organizing team;

5.5. **Culmination Day.** There shall be a culmination day of the weeklong observance and celebration of the Linggo ng Kabataan in the Municipality. This day shall constitute series of games, team-building activities, and recreation which promotes to strengthen relationships between Ogtonganon youths and particularly, youth organizations as members of the Local Youth Development Council (LYDC).

5.6. Other programs, projects and activities as maybe promulgated jointly by the Local Youth Development Council and the Sangguniang Kabataan Federation and deemed relevant to the celebration of the Linggo ng Kabataan.

Section 6. STEERING COMMITTEE. The Local Youth Development Council of Oton, spearheaded by the SKMF President and SKMF Vice President as Chairperson and Vice Chairperson, respectively shall serve as the steering committee of the Linggo ng Kabataan celebration in the municipality. The Steering Committee shall design and determine the programs and activities to be included in the celebration and shall spearhead the implementation of these.

Section 7. SOURCE OF FUND. Initial funding to defray the expenses necessary for or incidental to the implementation and institutionalization of the programs and activities of this ordinance in the amount of **Two Hundred Thousand Pesos** shall be sourced from the fund of the municipal government and is hereby allocated. Every year thereafter, at least Php 200,000.00 shall automatically be included in the annual budget of the municipality for the implementation and enforcement of this ordinance which shall be subjected to the usual accounting and auditing procedures in the disbursement of funds.

Section 8. APPLICABILITY CLAUSE. The provisions of existing ordinances dealing on the same subject matter which are not in conflict with, or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby adopted and made integral part of the Ordinance.

Section 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provisions, part or portion of the Ordinance shall be held invalid, the provisions, parts or portions of this Ordinance not otherwise affected thereby shall remain valid and effective.

Section 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. All municipal ordinances or parts of any municipal ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended and/or modified accordingly.

Section 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval of the Local Chief Executive.

Section 12. Copies. This Ordinance shall be furnished to the Office of the Mayor; LYDC; SKMF; MBO; MTO; Actg. Office; MPDC; MSWDO; PESO; MLGOO; DepEd Oton; Oton PNP; LNB; 37 barangays; Youth Organizations in Oton; and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Iloilo for information, guidance and review respectively.


