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ORDINANCE NO. 2023 – 431

AN ORDINANCE ENHANCING THE DELIVERY OF MEDICAL / HEALTH CARE SERVICES THROUGH MOBILE CLINIC AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR.

ON MOTION OF THE PROPONENT Hon. Jimmy R. Olivares, Chair, Committee on Health and Sanitation together with Hon. Ernesto C. Ticao and Hon. Hyacinth C. Gardose and **DULY SECONDED** by Hon. Lee C. Alison-Bretaña

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan ng Oton, that;

SECTION 1. RATIONALE

Medical services and nutrition program need to be enhanced for the Ogtonganons who live in far barangays and find difficulty in going to the Health Clinic.

This program will provide flexible health services that will benefit the needy, the people with discomfort or disability and the poor by providing them an efficient quality healthcare services.

SECTION 2. LEGAL BASES

The 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines declares that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, accords every local government unit the power and authority to promote the general welfare within its jurisdiction, including the promotion of health and safety of its constituents;

The Universal Health Care Act aims to ensure that all Filipinos are guaranteed equitable access to quality health care, goods and services.

Executive Order dated September 13, 2023, Office Order No. 25, dated September 11, 2023 of the Municipal Mayor. Subject: The designation of Mobile Team Members and their Itinerary.

SECTION 3. SHORT TITLE. – This ordinance shall be known as the, “**OTON MOBILE CLINIC ORDINANCE**”.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- a. **MOBILE CLINIC** is a scheduled, self-contained medical mobile team that shall deliver health services from one community to another to provide essential and accessible medical and health services to all 37 Barangays in the Municipality of Oton.
- b. **MEDICAL SERVICES** – Any maintenance care of or preventive care for the human body or care, service or treatment of an illness or disfunction of or injury to the human body.
- c. **HEALTH CARE SERVICES** – any services provided by a health care professional or by any individual working under the supervision of a health care professional that relates to: a) diagnosis, prevention or treatment of any human disease or impairment b) the assessment or care of the human beings.

SECTION 5. OBJECTIVES OF MOBILE CLINIC

- a) To enhance the health care services of the Oton Municipal Health Center/ Oton Rural Health Unit/ Oton Primary Care Facility by providing wider health care coverage to every Ogtonganon.
- b) To adopt a versatile and flexible system in providing healthcare services.

c) To provide an innovative design and deliver medical health services to far areas of the Municipality of Oton that need health services.

SECTION 6. MOBILE CLINIC SCHEDULE AND MECHANICS

- a. The Mobile Clinic is scheduled Monday to Friday 8:00 A.M to 12:00 Noon; 1:00 to 5:00 PM or may be changed, as recommended by the MHO Head, upon the approval of the Mayor.
- b. Simple Treatment procedures and Consultation services shall be the same as that in the Municipal Health Center and special cases shall be referred to the proper Medical Specialist.
- c. The Barangay Health Worker (BHW), Punong Barangay, Barangay Kagawad-Chair Committee on Health, and the Midwife assigned in the barangay shall facilitate the identification of beneficiaries / patients and shall schedule the Barangay to avail the Mobile Clinic.

SECTION 7. MOBLIE CLINIC TEAM COMPOSITION:

The Mobile Clinic Team shall be composed of the following:

- a. One Medical Doctor (Medical Officer III) and
- b. One Medical Doctor (Medical Officer I) Contract of Service
- c. One Medical Technologist I
- d. One Nurse I
- e. One Midwife I
- f. Two support staff – 1- (Admin Aide III) and 1 – Utility Worker 1 (Admin Aide 1)
- g. One Driver (Admin Aide III)

SECTION 8. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MUNICIPAL HEALTH OFFICE (MHO)

- a) Formulate and develop regulations and guidelines necessary to implement this ordinance.
- b) Formulate and provide guidelines for the operation of mobile clinic.
- c) Establish training programs for medical team that is necessary for the operation of mobile clinic.
- d) Establish, reorient and modernize the facilities of mobile clinic to be able to provide efficient and effective medical services.
- e) In-charge of the operation of mobile clinic, upon consultation and approval of the LCE.
- f) Recommend for the purchase of additional equipment for the mobile clinic, when necessary.
- g) Formulate, develop, and implement a community mobile health clinic program. In coordination with relevant government agencies, create a framework for medical health awareness program to promote effective strategies regarding medical health care, its components and services, as well as to improve awareness on stigmatized medical condition;

SECTION 9. FUNDING. These shall be an allocation of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P2,500,000) for the purchase of vehicle and Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P7,500,000.00) for the operating expenses, supplies and resources for the implementation of this Ordinance under the Municipal Health Office budget allocation.

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall continue in operation.

SECTION 11. REPEALING CLAUSE. All municipal ordinances or parts of any municipal ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 12. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval of the Local Chief Executive.

SECTION 13. COPIES. This Ordinance shall be furnished to the Office of the Mayor, MBO, MTO, Acctg., MPDC, MHO, MDRRMO, HRMO, Administrator, Legal Officer, Liga ng mga Barangay, 37 Barangays, MLGOO, Federated BHW, MSWDO, and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Iloilo for information, guidance and review respectively.


