ORDINANCE NO. 2023 – 439

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING “UGSARAN KO -TINLO KO” AS A MULTI-SECTORAL APPROACH IN ENSURING CLEANLINESS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF OTON, ILOILO.

AS PROPOSED BY Vice Mayor Jose Neil P. Olivares, **ON MOTION** of Hon. Paul M. Buenafe Chairperson Committee on Culture, History Arts and Tourism together with Hon. Lee C. Alison-Brelaña and Hon. Ma. Lorna T. Geonigo, **DULY SECONDED** by Hon. Ma. Lorna T. Geonigo, be it

ORDAINED as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan ng Oton, Iloilo that:

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF POLICY

A. It is hereby a declared policy of the Local Government Unit of Oton, Iloilo that it takes a village to clean a village. Therefore, inhabitants are enjoined to join the local government unit in achieving the intents of this ordinance.

B. The abovementioned policy is anchored on the General Welfare Clause (Section 16, RA 7160), which empowers this local government unit to promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, and to preserve the comfort and convenience of its inhabitants.

C. By virtue of Section 447 (a) (4) (ii) of RA 7160, it is the policy of this local government unit that premises of buildings and any land within the territorial jurisdiction of Oton shall be kept and maintained in a sanitary condition.

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS – As used for the purpose of this ordinance, the following terms are defined as:

A. Ugsaran – also known as public or private Front yard which means an enclosed or open yard in front of a house or building, located between the house or building and the street, road or highway, including the parking areas, sidewalk, curb and gutter of such street, road or highway, including the premises of parking and vending areas.

B. Tinlo ko – means the act of cleaning one’s ugsaran by virtue of this ordinance. It includes cleaning the ugsaran to be free from trash, earthen dirt/ excavated materials, animal wastes, any kind of nuisance per se or by accident such as protruding twigs or branches or undesirable hanged clothes or materials.

SECTION 3. REGULATORY CLAUSE

A. It shall be the duty of owners or operators of malls, and all commercial establishments to clean their ugsaran;

B. It shall likewise be the duty of all school heads/principals/administrators, heads of local and national agencies, vendors and their associations, drivers and their associations, Punong Barangays, and the owners or inhabitants of residential houses/structures/buildings and homeowner’s association in case of subdivision, to clean their respective ugsaran;

C. Owners of Junk shops/Stores shall enclose the area where their stocks are stored with non-transparent materials so that their stocks are not exposed to public view.

SECTION 4. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

A. Government entities tasked to maintain cleanliness in public sidewalks and streets, roads or highways shall continue to operate based on their mandate;

B. The Liga ng mga Barangay (LnB) and the Pambayang Pederasyon ng mga Sangguniang Kabataan (PPSK) shall assist this LGU in championing this ordinance in their localities;

C. Persons responsible to maintain the cleanliness of their ugsaran as mentioned in Section 3 hereof, shall dispose their trash properly based on the prevailing solid waste management ordinance during the schedule for collection of solid waste by the MENRO-GSO of this LGU;

D. The Ugsaran Cleanliness Team is hereby created. It shall be composed by the heads of the BRESTF as Team Leader, MENRO, GSO, Tourism Office, Public Schools District Supervisor (PSDS), and the presidents of the LnB and the PPSK. It is an Oversight Team on Ugsaran Ordinance which may be convened by the LCE or by the Beautification and Restoration Task Force (BRESTF) head, upon instruction of the LCE, from time to time when the need arises to collate data or situationer on how this ordinance is implemented, or collate suggestions for legislation on how to further improve the implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any portion or provision of this Ordinance is declared void or unconstitutional, the remaining portion thereof shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance having no penal provision shall take effect immediately upon approval of the Local Chief Executive.


SECTION 8. COPIES. This Ordinance shall be furnished to the Office of the Mayor; MTO, Acctg, MBO, MPDC, MENRO, MDRRMO, MEEDO, MEO, MOBO, Other LGU departments, DepEd elementary and Secondary, PCCI-Oton Chapter, Business Establishments, HOA-Subdivisions in Oton, Tourism, MACO, MENRO, Legal Officer, SK President, Liga ng mga Barangay, 37 barangays, MLGOO, Civil Organizations, and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Iloilo for information, guidance and review respectively.
