**RESOLUTION REQUESTING HON. SOFRONIO L. FUSIN, JR. MAYOR
MUNICIPALITY OF OTON, ILOILO TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE
SIXTEEN (16) PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS AND FIVE (5) PUBLIC HIGH
SCHOOLS OF THIS MUNICIPALITY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A UNIFIED
DESIGN AND COLOR CODED MATERIALS RECOVERY FACILITY (MRF).**

WHEREAS, Republic Act 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, declares the policy of the state in adopting a systematic, comprehensive and ecological waste management program that ensures the protection of public health and the environment and the proper segregation, collection, transport, storage, treatment and disposal of solid waste through the formulation and adoption of best environmental practices;

WHEREAS, Local Government Units are mandated to establish Material Recovery Facility in each barangay designed to receive, sort, process and store compostable, and recyclable materials efficiently;

WHEREAS, the school as an integral part of the community is the best avenue to educate learners on proper waste segregation and disposal practices and enhance awareness on the effects of global warning due to improper handling/management of garbage;

WHEREAS, providing a unified, color-coded MRF in schools will encourage all learners to consistently practice waste segregation and disposals at an early age;

WHEREAS, this act is also in support to the enhancement of the School Based Management (SBM) Program of Schools;


