ORDINANCE NO. 2025 – 486

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARAGRAPH A, SECTION 308 OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2017-314.

ON MOTION of Hon. Dennis Q. Geroche, Chair Committee on Public Order and Safety and Disaster Risk Reduction and duly seconded by Hon. Ma. Lorna T. Geonigo,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Oton, Province of Iloilo, assembled, that:

SECTION 1. RATIONALE: The Local Chief Executive requested for an amendment to Section 308, paragraph A of Municipal Ordinance 2017-314. *“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2013-256 ENTITLED “THE MUNICIPAL TAX AND REVENUE CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF OTON, ILOILO” PARTICULARLY ON FEES AND CHARGES UNDER CHAPTERS III, IV AND V.”* - “A) the peddling or sale outside the public market or premises of food stuff, which easily deteriorate like fish and meat is hereby prohibited. The phrase “is hereby prohibited” shall be changed to “shall be regulated.”

This changes will allow controlled peddling activities to continue under strict conditions, the word regulating, rather than outright prohibiting, such activities can provide a balanced approach to livelihood and health safety, provided that clear guidelines and enforcement mechanisms are established. The LCE through an Executive Order until such time the market code provides for clear and comprehensive regulations shall issue regulations pertaining to the implementation of the provision.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY PROVISION:

The underline provisions shall be the amendments to Section 308, Paragraph A of Municipal Ordinance 2017-314:

“A) the peddling or sale outside the public market or premises of food stuff, which easily deteriorate like fish and meat **shall be regulated. The Local Chief Executive shall issue the necessary regulations for the implementation of this provision through an Executive Order.**”

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. Based on Section 511 of the Local Government Code, this Ordinance with penal sanctions shall take effect either on the day following its publication, or at the end of three (3) consecutive weeks period of posting, whichever occurs later.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. All municipal ordinances or parts of any municipal ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5 SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall continue in operation.

SECTION 6. COPIES. This Ordinance shall be furnished to the Office of the Mayor; Oton-PNP; BPLO, MTO, MEEDO, BLGF, MPDC, Liga ng mga Barangay, OMVA, Presidents of Fish and Meat Section, 37 Barangays, Oton- PNP, Legal Officer, and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Iloilo for information, guidance and review respectively.
